GoodVision USA, together with our Liberian partner, Refuge Place International (RPI), provided free eye testing and screening to all members of the Liberia National Police in the capital city of Monrovia. This was a first for the national police force and was made possible because GoodVision Technicians and RPI staff were able to bring all of the necessary equipment to police headquarters. Providing on-site services allowed officers and supporting personnel to fit appointments into their busy schedules.

Almost 300 police officers were screened during the 7-day outreach event. More than 100 pairs of affordable eyeglasses were sold. Members of the force were very pleased with the customized strength of the lenses and the great fitting and stylish metal frames. The <u>durability of the glasses</u> was a critical feature for many, due to the nature of their work.
