
Matee Morris, Liberia Program Director, especially enjoyed the Country Development Workshop, where she learned what GoodVision teams were doing in other countries. The GoodVision team in Kenya, for example, works in other facilities and organizations, including some where there are no eye care activities. "This concept ... taught me that we can do a lot working with others than our own team."

Sayma Forkay, Co-Program Director, was also enthusiastic about finally meeting colleagues in person. Upon landing in Germany, Karsten Wolf welcomed them "warmly, with sweets and fruit bags. He took us to Zeitwohnhaus Hotel in Erlangen and ensured our rooms were ready. He also took us to a fascinating restaurant with old-fashion designs." Personal connections strengthened the value of the work sessions. "I took home some ideas on how countries like Burkina Faso expanded their network and solved their challenges, also how India incorporated others to empower them."

Despite flight delays, lost luggage, unfamiliar food, and going from summer weather at 30°C to winter weather of -6°C and back again in just a few days, both Matee and Sayma found the trip worthwhile. "We have [updated] our plans with ideas we acquired at the strategy meeting," Sayma reported. "I am optimistic that we will yield good sales this New Year." They agreed that visiting the Christmas market was a highlight, although according to Matee, "the place was cold for me! Next time if I am to go to Germany during the same season I [will] know how to prepare."
