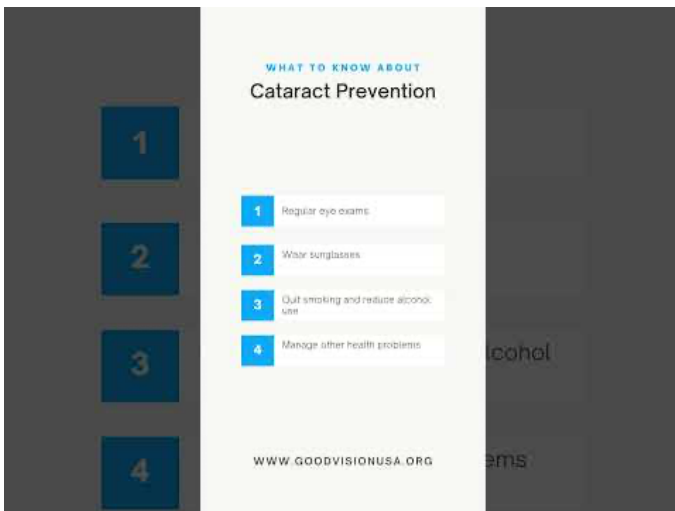

In case you missed it...

June is national cataract awareness month. Over half of all Americans age 80 or older have cataracts or have had surgery to remove them. Cataracts are a clouding of the eye's lens that blocks or changes the passage of light into the eye. Signs and symptoms include: clouded, blurred, or dim vision; increasing trouble with night vision; sensitivity to light and glare; needing brighter light for reading; seeing "halos" around lights; frequent changes in eyeglass prescriptions; fading or yellowing of colors; and double vision in a single eye.
