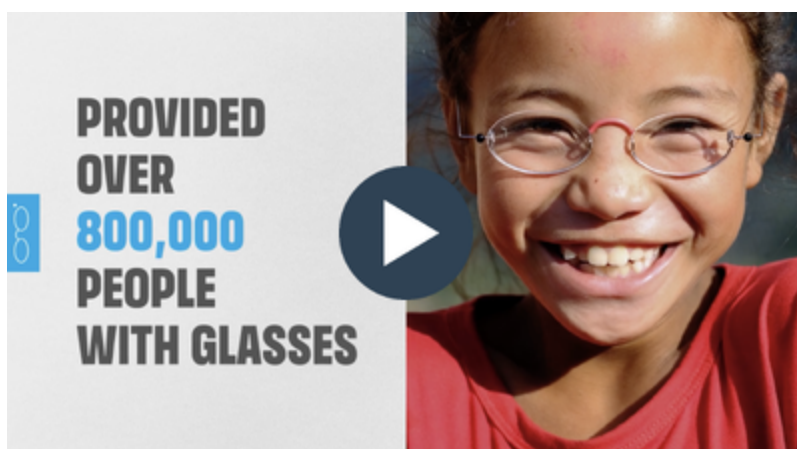




Thanks to our donors, 2024 was our most impactful year ever and was made possible because so many of you invested in our transformative work around the world. Thank you!

In December, GoodVision Executive Director, Matt Gianino, and others from GoodVision International had an incredible trip to India. Not only was Matt able to meet many of the over 100 employees that are part of the GoodVision India team, but he had the unforgettable experience of visiting several communities that were receiving vision care, including glasses, from the GoodVision team. "Seeing how care and professionalism saturated our team members' approach to their work was inspiring while hearing the

stories directly from countless beneficiaries of how receiving GoodVision glasses changed their life pulled everything into focus for me." In addition to visiting two of GoodVision's Vision Centers (these are small local clinics where anyone from the community can have a free eye screening and receive the necessary vision care they need), Matt was able to attend several eye camps the GoodVision India team coordinated for hundreds of individuals including at an elementary school, a biscuit factory, and several other communities.
